## Sample Bequest Language

Bequests to Amazon Watch are generally either for a specific sum or for the residue (or a percentage of the residue) of the estate. The following are some examples:

- Residuary or Percentage Bequest: "I give, devise and bequeath to Amazon Watch, a non-profit corporation of the State of Montana, located at 520 3rd St. Suite 108, Oakland, CA 94607, all the residue of my estate" (or "X% of the residue of my estate").
- Specific Amount Bequest: "I give, devise and bequeath to Amazon Watch, a non-profit corporation of the State of Montana, located at 520 3rd St. Suite 108, Oakland, CA 94607, the sum of US \$\_\_\_\_\_."
